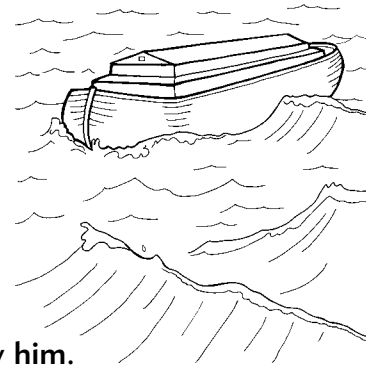

☆Let's Talk

SAY God saw that the people he had made did not love and obey him. God said he would send a flood, but he promised to save Noah and his family. God showed his love and goodness to Noah. Because of God's favor, Noah trusted and obeyed him. Noah did as God said when he built an ark to save himself, his family, and some of every kind of animal from the coming flood.

ASK *What happened after the flood?*

SAY When Noah, his family, and the animals left the ark for dry land, Noah offered a sacrifice and worshiped God. He praised God for taking care of them.

ASK God made another promise to Noah. *What was it?*

SAY God promised never again to destroy the earth with a flood. God sent a rainbow as a sign that he would keep his promise.

☆Let's Play

- 1 Play *All Aboard!* Gather **pictures of animals** whose sounds are easily made by children (dog, cat, duck, pig, cow, etc.). Put the pictures in a **bag**. Mark off an ark-shaped area on the floor with **masking tape**. Have children gather in pairs at the other end of the room.
- 2 Have all the pairs pick a card, look at the picture, and then put it facedown. At your signal, all the pairs will crawl or "fly" as fast as they can to the "ark" while making their animals' sounds. The first pair there is the winner!
- 3 Once inside the ark, have each pair take turns making the sound of their animal while the rest of the children guess what kind of animal they are.



☆Let's Draw

Hand out **paper** and **crayons** for the children to draw and color a rainbow of promise.



☆Let's Pray

Dear God, thank you for watching over me all the time. Thank you for your faithful care and for keeping your promises. Help me to trust you and obey. In Jesus' name, Amen.
